

Amarillo Area Mothers of Multiples Proposed Bylaw Chages

February 2015

Article IV Officers

CURRENT BYLAW: SECTION III TERM OF OFFICERS

Officers shall be elected at the March meeting and term of office shall be one year or until successors are elected. No officer shall be eligible to hold the same office for more than two consecutive years.

PROPOSED BYLAW: SECTION III TERM OF OFFICERS

Officers shall be elected at the March meeting and term of office shall be one year or until successors are elected. No officer shall be eligible to hold the same office for more than two consecutive years without membership approval.

PROPOSED CHANGE: Allow an officer to hold an office for more than two consecutive years with membership approval.

CURRENT BYLAW: SECTION VI DUTIES OF OFFICERS

D. 3RD VICE PRESIDENT

The 3rd Vice President shall be responsible for distributing and reporting on materials received from Texas Mothers of Multiples and the National Organization of Mothers of Twins Clubs, and for maintaining correspondence with each of these groups. She shall be responsible for research.

PROPOSED BYLAW: ARTICLE IX COMMITTEES AND DUTIES

Standing Committees are those appointed for the club year and include: Publicity, Projects, Membership, Nominating, Social, Scrapbook, Hospitality, Research, and State Representative

PROPOSED CHANGE: Change the State Representative position from an officer to a standing committee.


TMOM Convention Highlights
